

With these objectives, CPD framework of PEC sets parameters under four dimensions including developmental activities (short courses, trainings, workshops, research publications, professional memberships, Member of any Technical Committee etc.), higher education, individual activities and on-job experience. This framework is for the ultimate benefits of engineers in their career development and renewal of registration as well as for elevation from registered engineer (RE) to Professional Engineer (PE) and also leading to International Professional Engineer (Int PE).

Under New Vision of CPD, specialized job-oriented and global certification courses are being introduced to enhance employability and on-job performance. PEC itself and through its its registered Professional Engineering Bodies (List available on PEC website), regularly conducts short course, trainings and seminars to facilitate the engineers in fulfilling the CPD requirements.
